






10. In The Night




It is nighttime. Joe and May are coughing.

The doctor is there. She looks at May and Joe.




"They will be all right," said the doctor. "When you get home, put this in the fridge."




"They can have it up to eight times a day if they are coughing."



Mother and Father brought Joe and May home.




"Good night," said Mother and Father. "Good night," said May and Joe.
