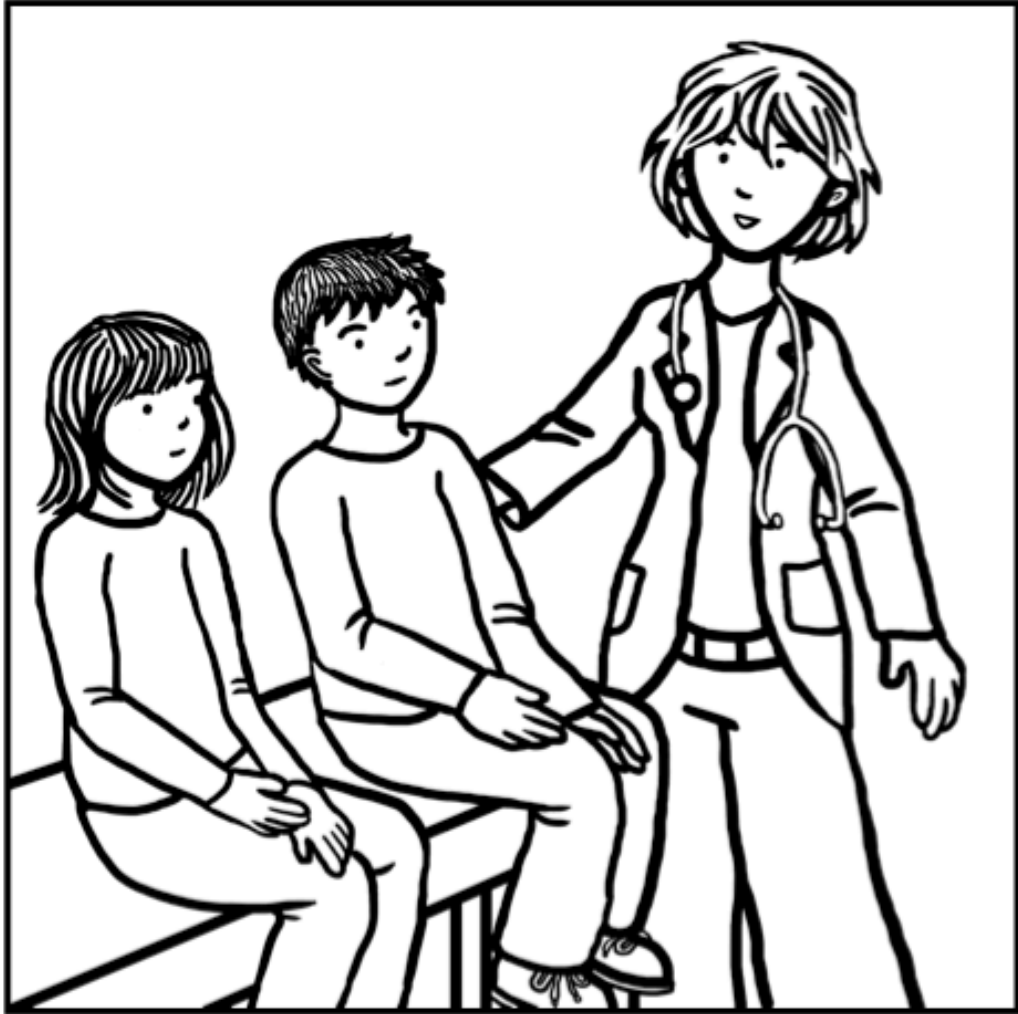
It is nighttime. Joe and May are coughing.

looks at May and Joe.



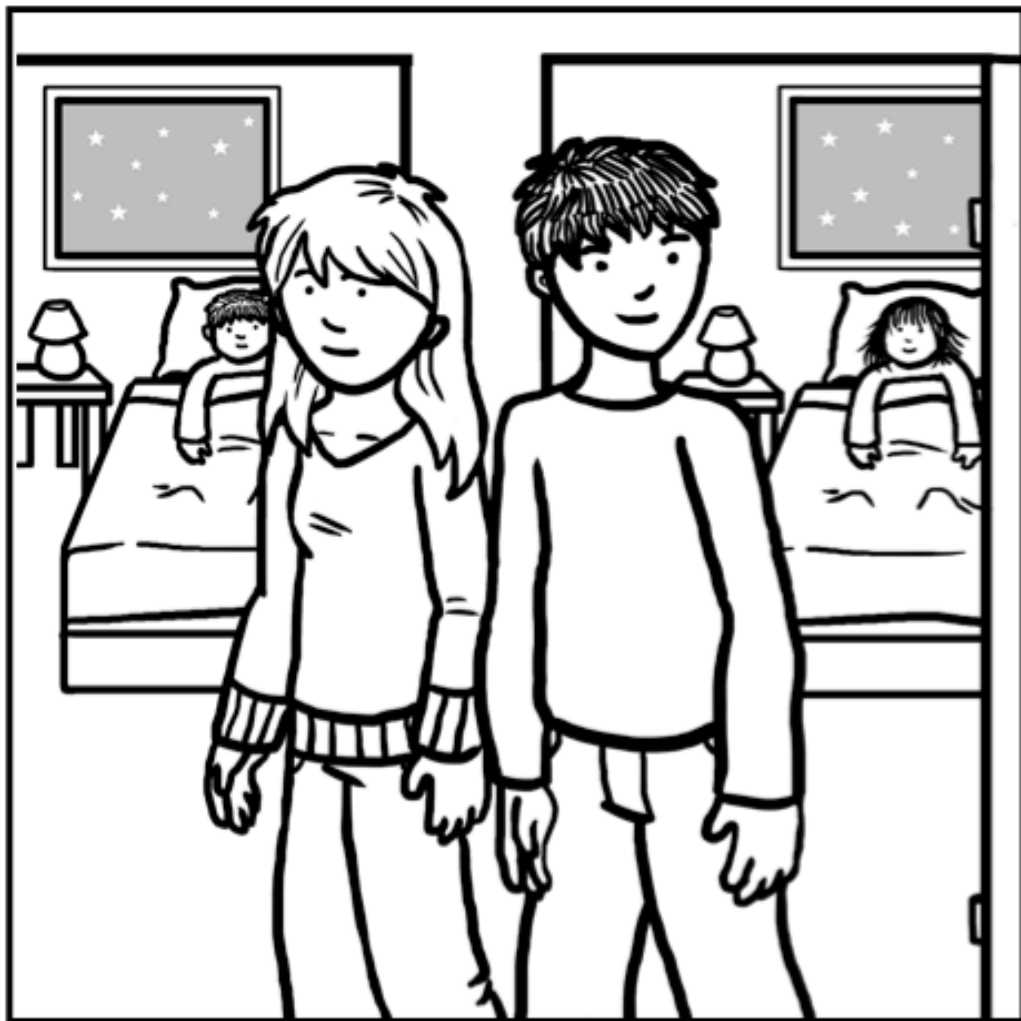
“They will be all right,”

“They can have it up to eight times a day if they are coughing.”

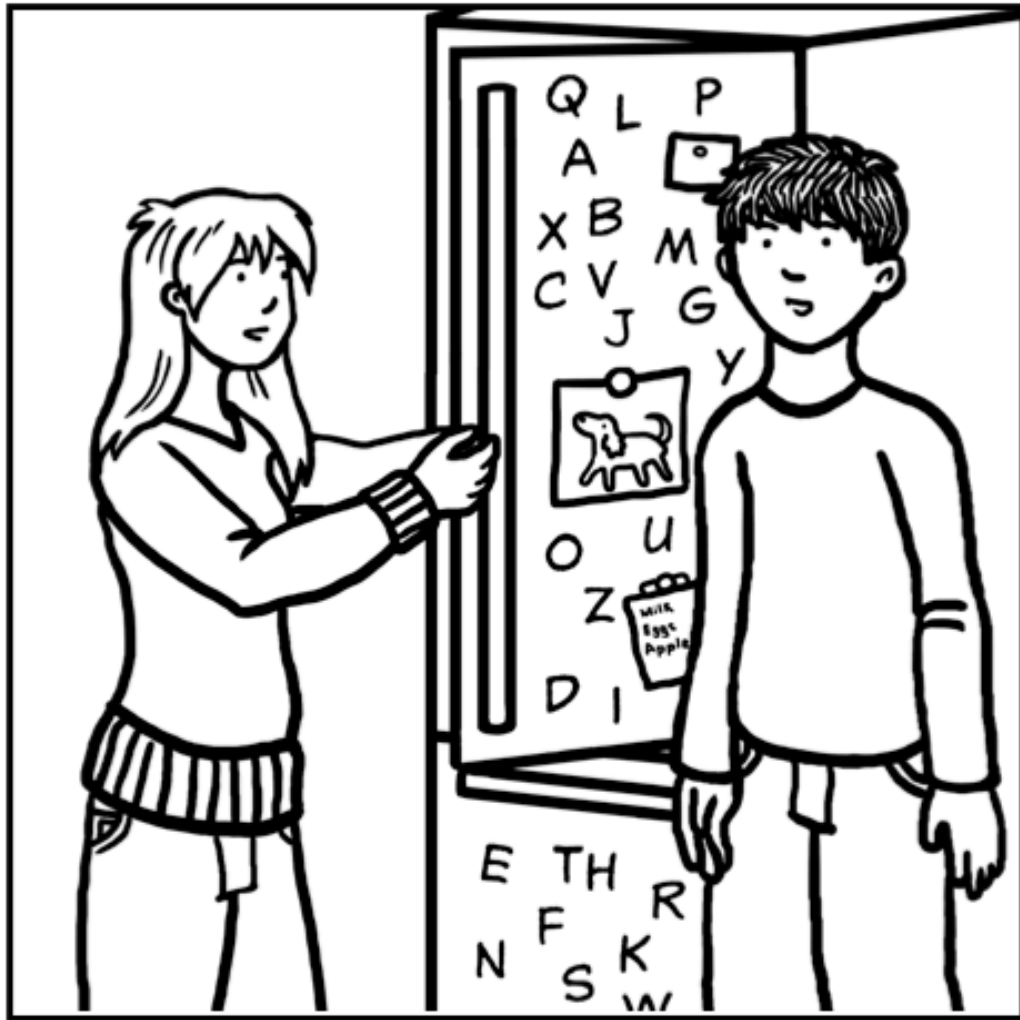


Mother and Father brought
Joe and May home.

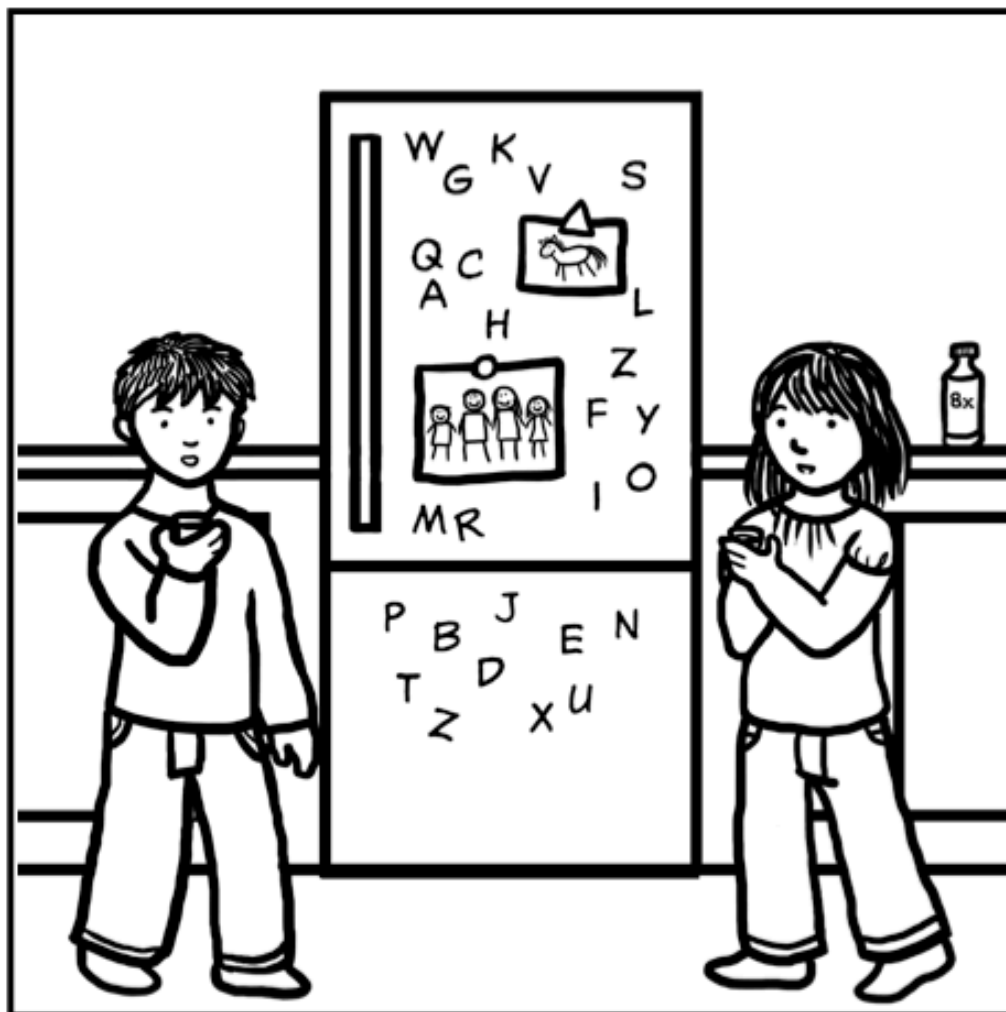


"Good night," said
Mother and Father.

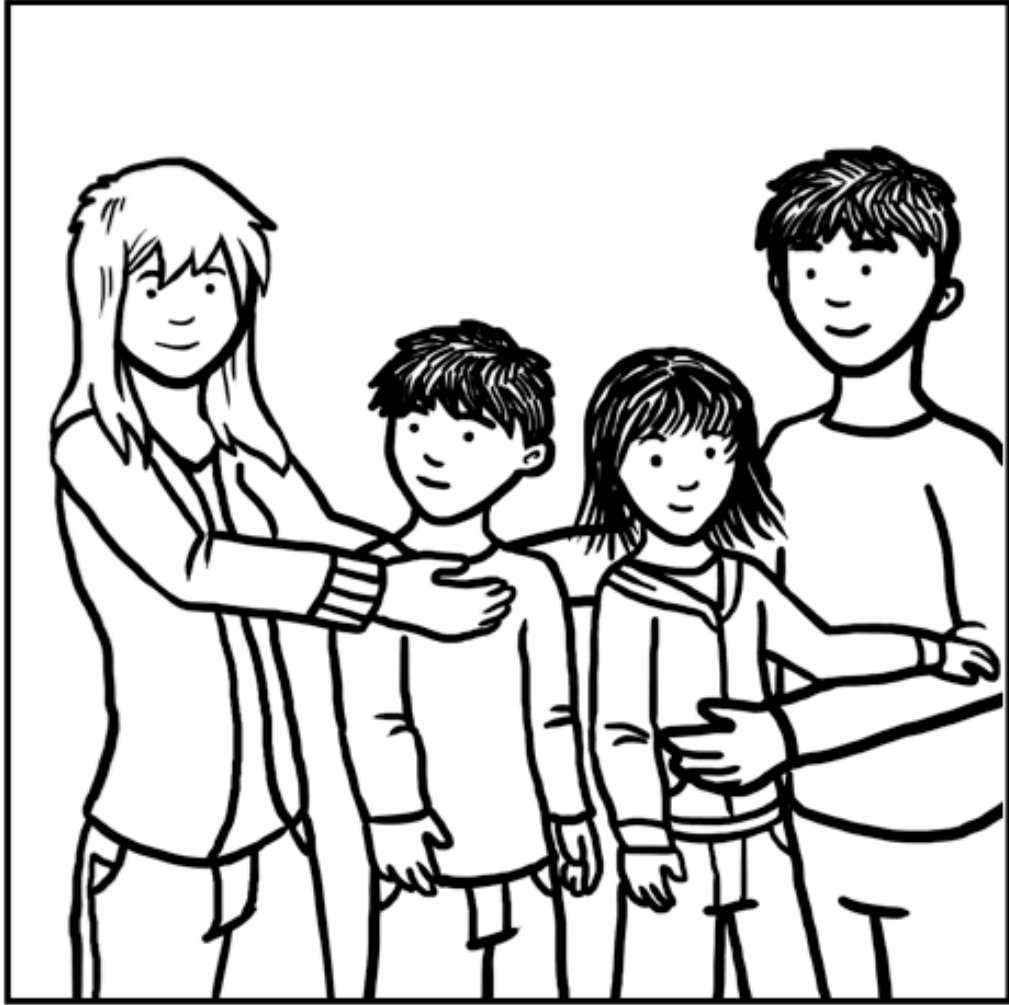
"Good night," said May
