He has a cute face.

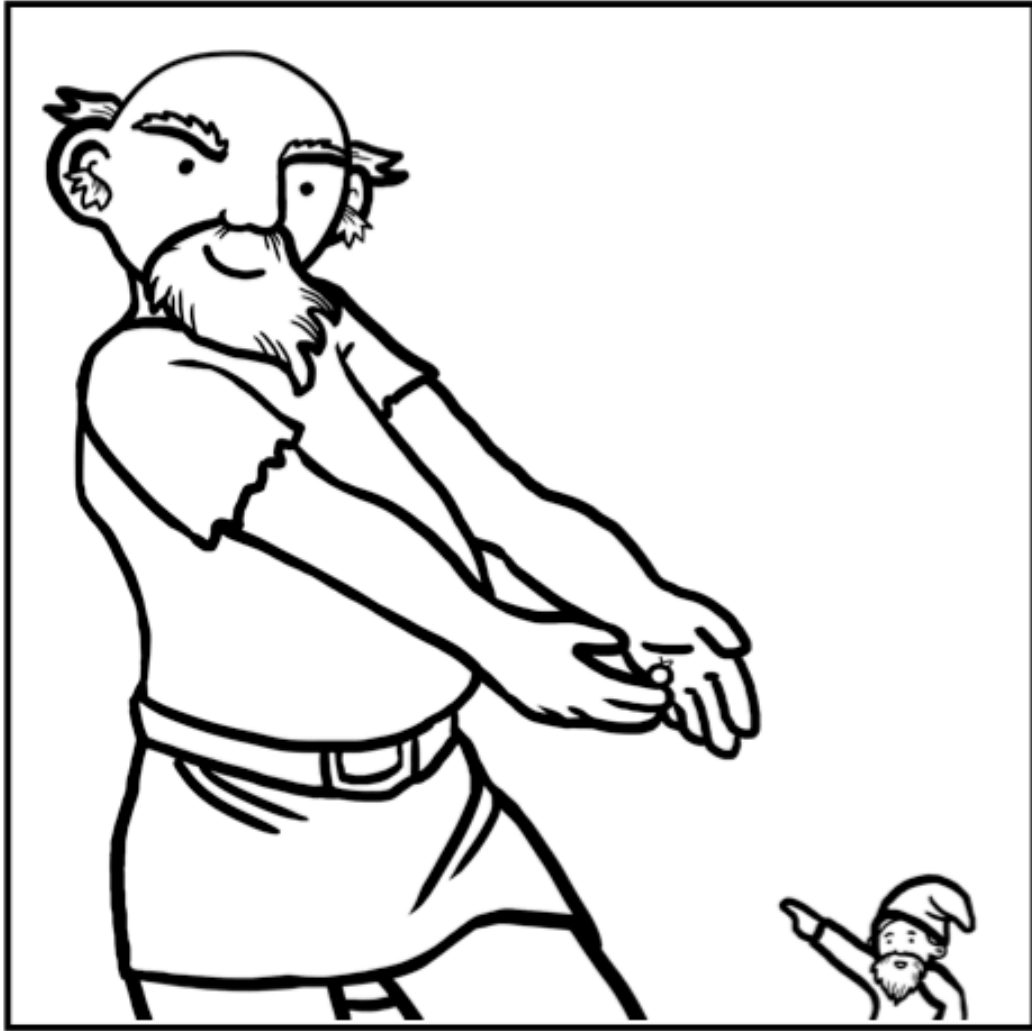


This is a big giant.

“You are bad.”



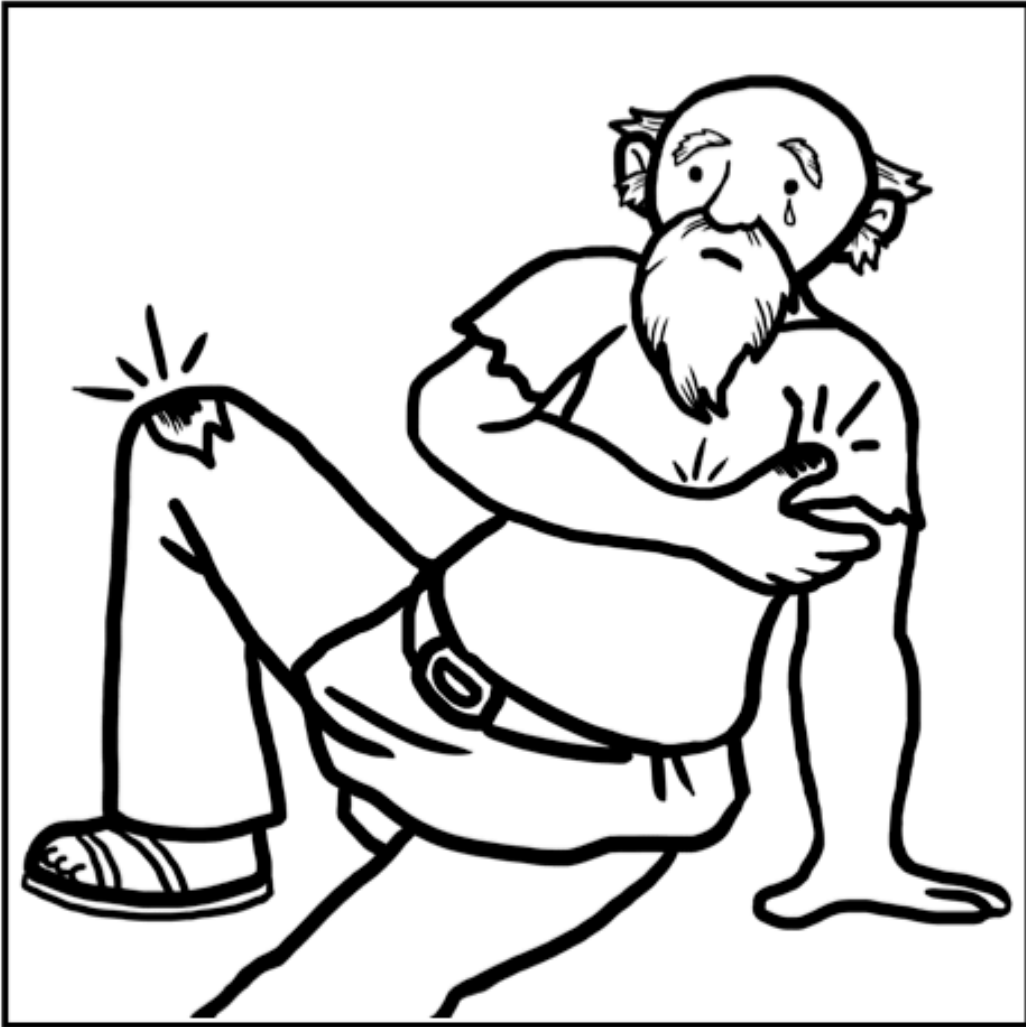
The giant was very,

The gnome ran too.



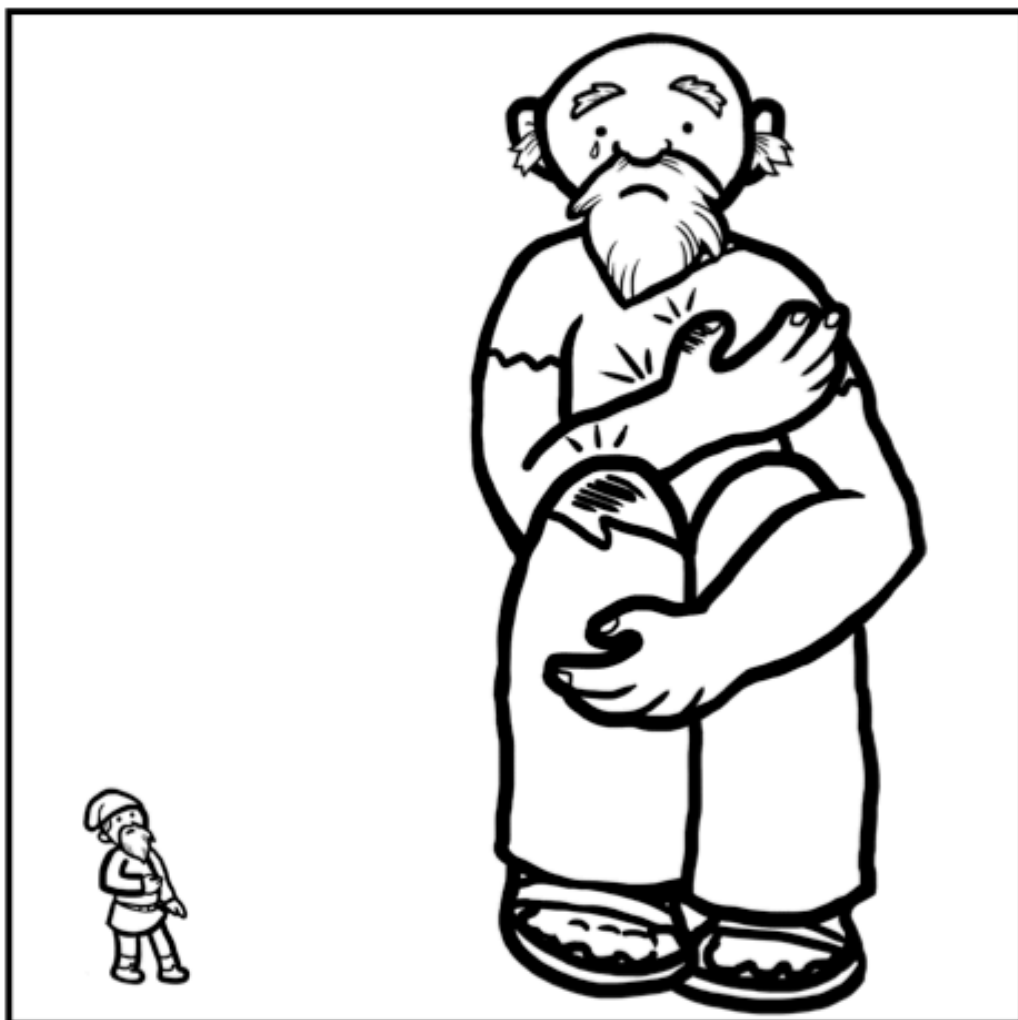
The gnome ran away.

not mad. It was sad.

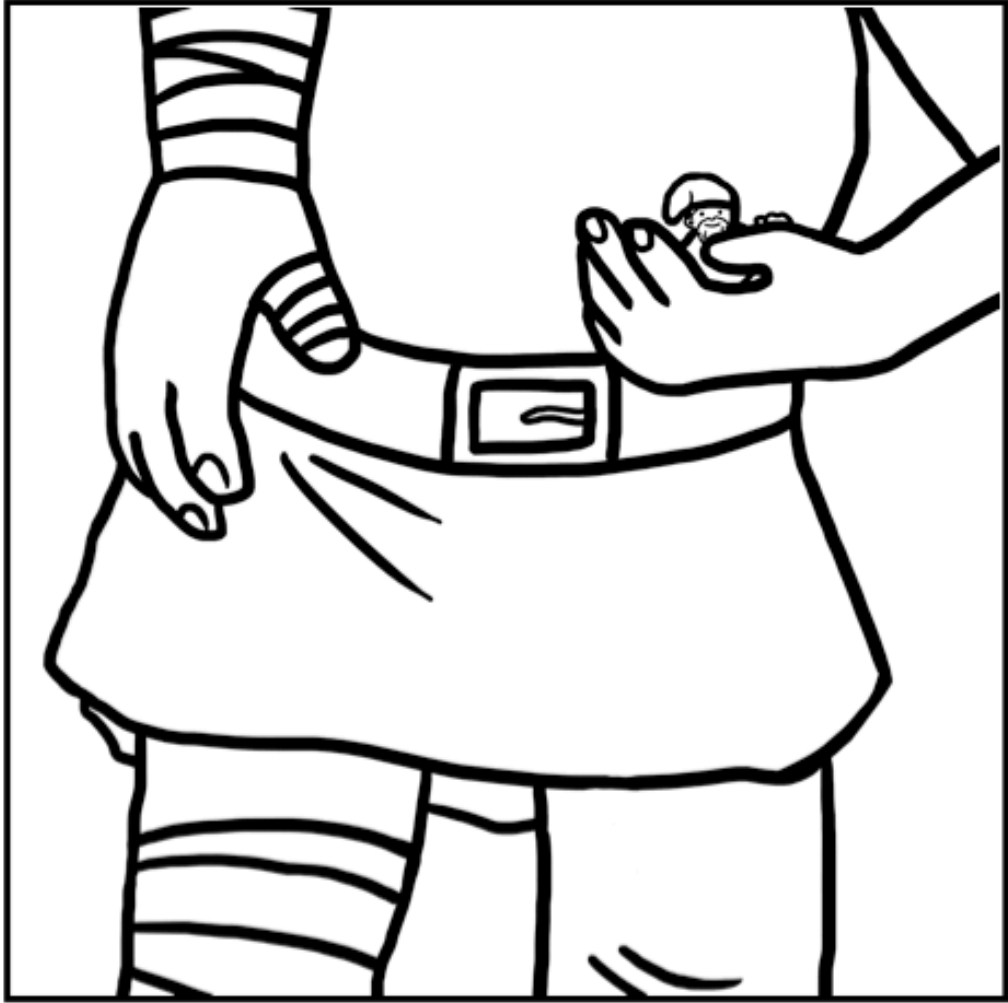


“I will get someone,”
